Sermon: It's All About Relationship

Affirmation of Faith (adapted from Revelation 7, NLT):

A vast crowd, too great to count, from every nation and tribe and people and language, are standing in front of the throne and before the Lamb. They are clothed in white robes and hold palm branches in their hands, shouting with a great roar, "Salvation comes from our God who sits on the throne and from the Lamb!" The angels are standing around the throne and around the elders and the four living beings. They fall before the throne with their faces to the ground and worshipping God, singing, "Amen! Blessing and glory and wisdom and thanksgiving and honor and power and strength belong to our God forever and ever! Amen." Those clothed in white are the ones who died in the great tribulation.
