## YOUTH MINISTRY

May has been busy month for our Young Disciples! Elementary, Middle and High School students made treat bags that were delivered for Teacher Appreciation Week to the local schools where our students are from. They also put together treats and cards for local police to thank them during National Law Enforcement week, that also included notes of appreciation from the congregation. Students planted beautiful flowers to take home as gifts for Mother's Day, and celebrated the end of an amazing year with a fun outside game day complete with water balloons.



Our High School students were busy this month not only working on the Teacher and Law Enforcement Appreciation gifts, but also in partnering with a local group to pack care packages for patients undergoing chemotherapy. We had the privilege of partnering with *Compassion for Chemo 906* for a packing night and put together 70 bags to be delivered across the UP. These bags are to help comfort and occupy patients as they undergo care and include blankets, fuzzy socks, lip balm, drink mixes, journals and adult coloring books, and toiletry items. We brought over a donations from our Church of Christian-themed journals and coloring books, along with bags of socks, colored pencils and other items that were needed. Students delivered bags to the Oscar Johnson VA and to the Marshfield Cancer Center where they toured their

compassion closet of items that patients have access to. We plan to continue this collaboration in the future and partner with them again on their packing days. If you are interested in helping, please reach out to me!

A group of 6 High School (and 1 elementary) students skipped school and made the trek up to Presbytery Point for their spring cleanup on May 9<sup>th</sup>. We spent a beautiful day in the sun raking, scrubbing mattresses and floors, organizing supplies and singing and getting the Camp ready for summer. Two of the students have attended Camp before and were excited to be back 'home', and 3 more are now planning on attending after spending the day there.
